## The Dressing Room



The Dressing Room is a free service that supplies the program's participants with proper clothing and accessories for job interviews and to start a new job. Each participant receives two interview outfits, undergarments, makeup, soaps, and lotion. Ninety percent of the participants are women, however, some gentlemen use the service as well.

Donated items may also be used to stock their second hand clothing store called Seconds on Court. The proceeds from this store assist in the support of the program and its continued success.
